An ebook is an electronic version of a printed book which can be read on a personal computer or hand-held device designed specifically for this purpose. eBooks are typically read on dedicated hardware devices known as ereaders or ebook devices. Personal computers and some cell phones can also be used to read ebooks.

ePub is now a standard ebook file format that is supported by almost every ebook reading device including Sony Reader, BeBook, IREX Reader, iPhone, and Barnes & Noble's Nook. Other than hardware devices, you can also read epub books on your desktop or mobile phone using free e-reader software like Stanza, Mobipocket, FBReader (for Linux), Aldiko (for Android) or Adobe Digital Editions.

Amazon Kindle uses a proprietary format (AZW) and cannot read epub files directly. However, you can use Stanza's free desktop application to convert an epub ebook into AZW (or even PDF), a format your Kindle can understand.
